Finding books and journals?

Chemistry Library

The chemistry library (CB) - a department of the University Library (UB) - is situated on Hagenring 30 (see also plan - picture on the back).

Here you will find books and journals concerning Chemistry, Food Chemistry and Chemical Technology on open access: about 43.000 media units. Literature concerning Biochemistry or Pharmaceutical Chemistry can be found on the second floor in the UB beyond the signature of BT or PM respectively.

The complete stock of the CB can be searched by the OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) and the computers in the CB enable access to the catalogues of the UB as well.

A map of the stock arrangements can be found by accessing the internet or by consulting the information desk in CB (see below!).

More electronical services like electronical journals (E-journals) are searchable by using the internet (www.biblio.tu-bs.de).

You can also make print copies and in addition read microfilms by using the corresponding devices.

Moreover, CB offers a larger lecture room equipped with blackboard, overhead- and video projector.

Textbook collection

Copies of chemistry textbooks are integrated in the textbook collection of the UB, located there at the ground floor (denoted by "Lehrbuchsammlung" in the online-catalogue). Holdings

Older books can be ordered from the closed stacks in the UB by using the online-catalogue. They have to be picked up at the University Library.

Internet

On the Homepage of the University Library (<http://www.biblio.tu-bs.de>) by clicking „UB von A-Z“ you will reach the CB-site, and beyond the point CoOL (**C**atalog of **O**bject **L**inks) you will find an overview of online links concerning libraries and the internet. Among others you will find lists of media, shelf arrangements, links to print- and E-journals, databases, bibliographies and in addition other useful links and information.

Databases

In the CB you have access to chemistry databases offered by "FIZ Karlsruhe, Germany" at "FIZ Karlsruhe serving higher education". Moreover, you can reach the full range of databases offered by the host *STN-International*, The Scientific and Technical Information Network (over 230 Databases, especially *CAS ONLINE* the world's biggest chemistry database). It is also possible to search with *ReaxysFile* a data collection which contains *BEILSTEIN handbook of Organic Chemistry*.

The journal articles database "Online Contents" and corresponding offers are summarized in "UB von A-Z / Online Contents" on the Homepage.
